

Directions for Trailer Parking for Carol Kozlowski Clinic Saturday, June 17 at Black Points Farm

BLACK POINTS FARM is in a residential area so there is limited parking for horse trailers. In order to be able to accommodate all the trailers, we have to park the Groups in different locations.

Groups 2 and 4 will park at the 50 Buggywhip address barn. We have enlarged the parking area so 5 trailers should be able to park there. Go past the yellow #50 Buggywhip Trail mailbox and turn left into the next driveway (post and rail fencing with a small Black Points Farm sign).

If you'd rather park on the road, continue down to the cul-de-sac, turn around, and park on the shoulder between the driveway to the barn and our #50 mailbox. Any trailer larger than a 2H should park on the shoulder. **DO NOT** park on the other side of the street, only park on our side.

Groups 1 and 3 will park on the shoulder of Parrish Road. The shoulder on the North side of Parrish Rd is wide enough for safe trailer parking and it's only a short distance to the driveway to the jump field - marked with orange tape. **Do NOT park to the east of the jump field driveway.** Park on the **north side** - opposite the white fencing and pond or by the open hay field. To get a better idea, go to Google Maps and put in 228 Parrish Rd, 14472.

AUDITORS: You should come in on Parrish road and either park on the shoulder and walk to the jump field or, you can go up the driveway and park in the area on your left, marked with orange cones.
